Dear Parents / Carers,

Welcome back to a new school year at Sacred Heart. This week the children have been writing Sacred Agreements based on the school rules of Be Ready! Be Safe! Be Respectful! Each class has explored what this looks like in school and created a charter which all of the children have signed up. These are referred to throughout the year.

Along with getting used to new faces and surroundings, the children have been learning new routines and consolidating old ones. There has been a focus on 'Staying Safe' across all classes in an age-appropriate way and today following a Mass to celebrate the new school year and Mary's birthday, the children have been learning about Mary, the Mother of God along with other inspirational women. This is the third year that we have celebrated this event and the children have been recapping on significant women in history that they have studied in previous years before adding to their knowledge portfolio.

We welcome new families to our school community in Reception along with children who have joined in other year groups too: lori, Kiera, Habiba and Jonath in KS2.

School Environment

You will have noticed the works being carried out on improving the EYFS outdoor area. The completion date was the end of August but we have been let down and the work is still ongoing causing disruptions at drop off and pick up. This new sheltered area will really make a difference to the outdoor provision meaning that the children can get outside whatever the weather. The new fencing and dismantling of the broken play equipment has provided extra playground space for the rest of the school, extending the surface area. It will be wonderful when complete.

From Monday 11th, can nursery parents please enter and pick up via the nursery side gate until further notice. This is for nursery only. Siblings will need to go in via the main entrance. There will be no access via the EYFS area as Mrs Pancott needs to be vigilant on the gate with our youngest children.

Meet the Teacher

We will be offering parents the chance to come in a see your child/ren's new teacher and classroom over the next couple of weeks. Even if you know the staff, you may not be familiar with the expectations and routines of the new year group so it is always
