

Year 3— Spring 1 2023 The Ancient Greeks



Welcome back year three! We hope you had a wonderful Christmas and are ready to begin a new year of learning!

This half term, our big question is 'Is Greece a democratic place to live?'

Our half term of learning will be driven by the knowledge we will be acquiring in history. The children will learn about primary and secondary sources of evidence about life in Ancient Greece and how their legacies influence modern lifestyles. In English, the children will be introduced to myths through Theseus and the Minotaur. They will then innovate their own beast before writing their own Greek myth.

In English

In English, we will be:

- Developing our understanding and use of varied vocabulary.
- Using full stops and capital letters accurately in writing.
- Extending sentences using conjunctions.
- Using expanded noun phrases to build description.
- Using prepositional phrases.
- Using paragraphs

In History

In History we will:

- Continue to sequence events on a timeline;
- Discover the location of Greece and Ancient Greece:
- Learn about Greek life;
- Discover about Greek Gods and Goddesses;
- Learn about changes in Greek architectural and military achievements which impact on our lives today.

Vocabulary

The development of vocabulary is important to us at Sacred Heart. Through this enquiry project we will develop the following vocabulary:

tyrant, exchanged, despise, justify, shimmer, preferred

Gods, Goddesses, military, democracy, armies, city states, temples, worship, architecture

IXL- 10 minutes daily practice on skills we have learnt in school




Google Classrooms
